









These are the 50 books we think Newtown Primary School children, in Reception, will love.

Children in Reception should read and be read to 10 minutes every day.



If your child has a favourite book, it is ok for them to read it repeatedly – this helps with their fluency and understanding of story structure.

It is important for your child to engage with what they are reading. To help them with this, you could:

- Let them act out the story while you read it
- Talk about interesting words and what is happening in the book
- Use expression and humour when reading to them
- Say rhymes and songs together and let your child fill in the rhyming words at the end of the sentence
- Make mistakes in familiar rhymes and stories for them to spot
- Listen to your child’s ideas and opinions
- Make links to things and places they are familiar with for example link the shop in the book to where you go food shopping.
